

The traditional application of falconry has been to take a Bird of Prey, train it and then attempt to catch wild quarry with it. Although our guided walks with hawks experience, is not a hunting expedition, it is a leisurely stroll through the majestic settings of Killarney with falconer and hawk/or team of hawks and shows the ability of trained birds and their relationship with their human partners. The participants will have hands on experience with the hawks, you will be able to handle and fly the hawk yourselves under instruction from Killarney falconry's falconers. We finish up with an owl encounter where you can handle & hold an owl.

Locations for Hawk Walks may change due to conditions but normally 5/10mins drive from Killarney town centre

Coming into Killarney town via MOLLS GAP,

Hawk Walk Location (N52\*04.767 / W009\*29.926)

Heading in for Killarney town centre, muckcross road, onto horse&carriage stand, around stand taking a left for Main Street, through High Street, Rock Road on to Cleeny Roundabout take 2nd Exit for Tralee/Kerry Airport continue 1/2km approx taking 1st Turn Right for Kilcummin L3018, Over the railway bridge pass the New Cemetery Graveyard, through the crossroads continue 300mtrs approx to the bend on the road, take Right Turn for Paudie Fitzgerald Motorcycles/Cul De Sac, down the small hill over the little bridge and Park on the Left where you will see a white Killarney Falconry vehicle. Any problem with directions just give a ring en route
